# ABOUT THE MUSIC IN TODAY'S SERVICE

Today is a Bach day! It had been thought, for many years, that J.S. Bach composed his '8 Little Preludes and Fugues' as instructional pieces for one of his sons, probably the oldest. As of late, this idea has come under scrutiny — many organ scholars tend to agree that the compositional style doesn't seem to fit that of Bach. Whoever the composer might be, they are great fun to learn and play.

There is no doubt, however, that Bach wrote his Prelude and Fugue in D Major during his stay as organist in Weimar, working for the Duke. The exact date of the composition is unknown, but it was probably written around 1710. Listen for the Fugue subject – three consecutive notes rising and falling and then developed. It will be this theme that will form the basis for the solo on the pedals that concludes the work.
