## ABOUT THE MUSIC IN TODAY'S SERVICE

In 1766, at the age of 10, Mozart was invited to play the Muller organ in Haarlem, Holland – a large instrument which had also been played by Handel. He spent several hours playing and improvising at the instrument, which is still quite playable today. It is believed that one of the themes he improvised was that of the Ave Verum – not to be confused with the motet of the same name (far more famous) which was written only weeks before his death in 1791.

Born in Venice, Marcello was a contemporary of Vivaldi. He was born into a patrician family; his father wanted him to become a lawyer. Marcello managed to combine his love of music and also serve his city, taking posts on the city council. His works include instrumental settings of the Psalms – in this case, Psalm 18:Vs. 6 In my distress I called to the LORD; I cried to my God for help. From his temple he heard my voice; my cry came before him, into his ears.




